- Visitor must present a verified negative result within the last week (7 days) from the date of the collection of the specimen. Visitation will be refused if the individual fails to present test results, exhibit any COVID-19 symptoms or do not pass the screening questions. A copy of the negative test result will be maintained by the facility (Antigen Point of Care testing is not an approved test).
- Visitor is screened for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 prior to resident access. Screening shall consist of both temperature checks and asking screening questions to assess potential exposure to COVID-19, which shall include questions regarding international travel or travel to other states designated under the Commissioner's travel advisory.
- Limited visitation includes, but is not limited to: family members, loved ones, representatives from the long-term care ombudsman program (LTCOP).
- Under certain limited circumstances, visitation can be inside in a well-ventilated space with direct access to hand washing stations.
 - Residents visiting each other - No more than 10 residents who are appropriately socially distanced or wearing a facemasks or face covering while in the presence of others.
 - Family Visits and LTC OP will be permitted in the following indoor space – Elm/Fir Dining hall and family dining room with no more than 2 visitors.
- Visitation will occur in outdoor areas, weather permitting (behind building in restricted area). If weather does not permit, the visit will occur in a well-ventilated indoor space (Elm/Fir Dining Room)
- At this time, visitation is strictly prohibited in resident rooms or care areas unless the resident is at end of life and medically unable to leave their room
- To follow appropriate social distancing rule, only 2 family members may attend at a time if they share the same household.
- Visitors under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult 18 years of age or older.
- Visitors must wear a face masks or face covering which covers both the nose and mouth at all times when on the premises of the NH/ACF's. If visiting inside, the visitor must wear full PPE (gown, gloves, face mask).
- Visitors must maintain social distancing and may not consume food or drink during the visit.
- Facility has provided alcohol-based hand rub, consisting of at least 60 percent (60%) alcohol, to residents, visitors and representatives of the long-term care ombudsman prior to visiting the residents. Rub hands together using friction.
- Visitation hours are by appointment only and for 30-minute durations.
- A copy of the NH's/ACF's formal visitation plan is posted on the website and broadcasted via social media.
- Staff are required to monitor the visitation process. If any visitor fails to adhere to the protocol, he/she/they will be prohibited from visiting for the duration of the COVID-19 state declared public health emergency.
